   This means parents are asked to observe practices from the designated spectator areas outside the field.
- Empower Player Growth: Learning involves making mistakes. We encourage a supportive environment where players feel comfortable trying new things, even if they stumble.
- Teamwork & Respect: A strong team bond is key. We strive to cultivate a respectful environment between coaches and players, allowing them to build trust and work together effectively.
- Maximizing Coaching Impact: Our qualified staff is dedicated to providing impactful instruction and training. Limiting distractions allows for clear communication and efficient learning.

## **Guidelines for Bridge, Academy & Select Teams:**

- Field Access: To minimize distractions and maintain a focused atmosphere, only
  authorized Pike Soccer staff, coaches, and players are permitted on the training field.
  This includes family members and team managers who should observe from designated
  spectator areas. Younger players may be walked to their designated field by a parent but
  should then leave the training area.
- Injury Management: In the case of an injury or medical emergency, Pike Soccer staff
  are trained and equipped to assess the situation and administer proper first aid. Family
  members may be involved in assisting with injury management as deemed necessary by
  Pike Soccer staff.
